

**FRANK GONZALEZ NAMED TREASURER OF PRESTIGIOUS
CINTAS FOUNDATION**

Gonzalez has also been involved with the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, the American Diabetes Association and the Association for Retarded Citizens.
